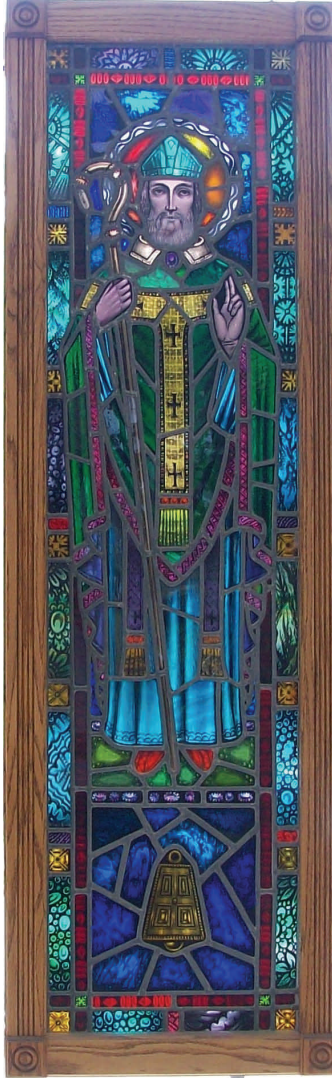

"Invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, the unwanted; blessed will you be because of their inability to repay you" (Luke 14:1, 7-14). A parishioner noted to his pastor that Jesus dined with the rich and famous of his day. He asked, "Do you think Jesus would belong to an exclusive country club if he were here today?" The pastor answered, "I suspect he might, if he could afford it.
