Over the years:

- The Russell House has offered counsel and support to women as they re-establish their identity as a person of worth and value,
- A House (honoring former physician, Dr. Barbara Russell) has been built that provides the shelter these women and children seek. Facilities and support can be provided for up to 62 women and children.
- Services are provided to those in Phelps County as well as those in our neighboring counties of Crawford, Dent and Maries.
