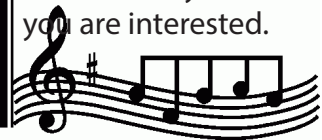

DID YOU KNOW?

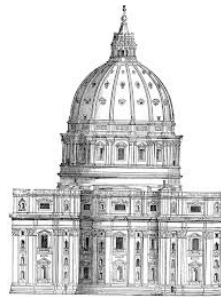
