World Day for Consecrated Life to be Celebrated February 3rd, 4th

In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer for women and men in consecrated life. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd. This Feast is also known as Candlemas Day; the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples. The celebration of World Day for Consecrated Life is transferred to the following Sunday in order to highlight the gift of consecrated persons for the whole Church.

Adult Education for Lent

The season of Lent is the perfect time to enrich your faith life and increase your knowledge in the truths and teachings of the Catholic Church! Join us for Part 1 or Part 2 or both.

Part 1: View the "Bishop" Series

Our diocese has put together an excellent series of 10 catechetical videos explaining various topics related to the position of bishop in the Catholic Church. We will view 2 of these sessions each week. What a timely learning tool as we welcome Bishop W. Shawn McKnight to our diocese on Feb. 6th.

Part 2: Read/Discuss the Catechism

At the Parish Center – Bring your notes. The discussion will begin after Part 1. We will watch the corresponding ECHO video for that day before our discussion.
