A message from the Pastor regarding Confession...

After receiving feedback and comments from several parishioners, I am asking everyone to please use the "traditional line" system as you wait your turn to go to confession. Namely, please begin the confession line behind the 14th Station of the Cross, and line up along the wall toward the back of church. Of course if at any point you find it difficult to remain standing, you should be able to use the end of a pew near you to sit for a few moments and move as the line moves.

PLEASE DO NOT sit anywhere else in church and then come up for confession. This method inevitably has people "cutting in line" in front of people who have been waiting.

We always add extra confession times in Advent and Lent, but I am pleased to add a regular confession time on the 1st Sunday of each month:
