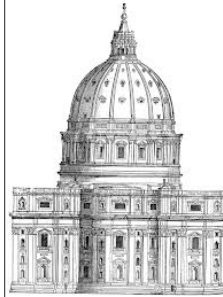
DID YOU KNOW?

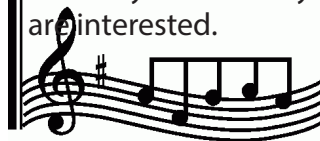
